### **Examples of Duties:**

Assists sergeants and other superior officers in the conduct of patrols, searches, surveillance, investigations and arrests. Supervises police officers and performs general law enforcement work in absence of superior officers. May perform police specialist duties in criminal investigation, crime prevention or police-community relations. Enforces laws pertaining to traffic including moving and non-moving violations. Answers complaints in the field and on the spot investigations. Conducts preliminary investigations of crimes. Testifies in court as a Government witness. Participates in search and rescue of persons reported missing on land or sea. Participates in fire-fighting. Is required to work at times of typhoon or other missing on land or sea. participates in road-blocks and provides protection to the public at areas where hazardous explosives are in progress. Is occasionally sent to other municipalities to provide on-the-field patrol training to other police detachments. Conduct fire prevention inspections in the community, advising house-holders and business firms of potential fire hazards. Administer first aid treatment to persons suffering from shock, injury, or suffocation and uses inhalator. Responds to the fire alarm; meeting arriving planes fire possible fire emergencies; assists in rescuing inhabitants from burning buildings. Supervises the maintenance of fire equipment. At times, supervises recruits in the performance of their duties. Performs other related duties as assigned.

### **Minimum Qualification Requirements:**

Graduation from two (2) years college in Police Science. Successful completion of Police Academy Training Program and four (4) years of Police work or closely related work.
